Smog City Heights to Open Soon

Well, readers, it's happening again. A Long Beach legend is opening a new spot in our neighborhood: Say hello to Smog City Heights.

Cal Heights-ers may be familiar with Smog City Brewing, a Torrance-based brewery with four taprooms, including the one at SteelCraft, the "urban eatery" on the corner of Long Beach Boulevard and East Bixby Road.

Now, owners/operators Laurie and Jonathan Porter are in the process of moving from SteelCraft to their new digs in Cal Heights. But now, in addition to offering their selection of famous craft beers, Smog City is adding food to the mix, with a menu developed by executive chef Jeff Lustre.

"We call it upscale fast-casual, or innovative fast-casual," Laurie said. "Burgers, chicken wings, fries, crispy Brussels sprouts, and some sandwiches and salads, but all made just a little elevated. We're also going to offer 'noshing' bar foods, like pickled vegetables and pickled eggs."

Laurie emphasized the overall experience Smog City will give its customers.

"We're taking things that we're really good at, and we're putting them all in here," she said. "Making sure that we're creating the best, warmest, most welcoming and safe environment for our customers that we possibly can, in every experience."

As of this writing, Laurie says Smog City will serve lunch and dinner—with plans for breakfast burritos in the future—and of course, their famous beers.

"It's really important that people who see we're moving know that we're not moving because we want to move, but we are doing something special here, and we're really excited about this next chapter," she said.

Long Beach Heritage invites you to celebrate the season with them!

The Bembridge House, a 119-year-old Queen Anne Victorian home under the care of Long Beach Heritage, is a City of Long Beach landmark and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and the California Register of Historic Resources.

The Bembridge House, built in 1906, is a magnificent and highly ornate example of late Victorian architecture. It is the single most important example of this style of architecture remaining in Long Beach today and is considered by many to be the most significant residential historic landmark structure in the city. Amazingly, the house is in almost pristine condition, and contains many of the original furnishings dating from the early 1900's.

Each year to celebrate the Spirit of Christmas, Hanukkah and Kwanza the home, inside and out, is dressed up with traditional sparkle, splendor and beauty. Each room is decorated by volunteers according to a theme and for 2025 the grand lady will be decked out in an "Enchanted Toyland" theme.

Daytime Tours:

Tuesdays: December 2, December 9, December 16 & December 23. All daytime tours are from 1:30-3:30 PM, no entrance after 3:00 PM.

Adults-only Nighttime Tours:

Mondays: December 15 & December 22

Wednesdays: December 3 & December 10

All nighttime tours are from 6:00-8:00 PM, no entrance after 7:30.

Parking can be a challenge near the Bembridge House. Walking, biking or use of a Rideshare is encouraged. 935 N Park Circle, Long Beach, 90813.

Regular tours are available after the holidays if you miss out in December.
